Workers' Compensation Benefits

What is Workers' Compensation? Whether an injured worker is covered by L&I's Washington State Fund, or a self-insured employer, he or she is entitled to no-fault accident and disability coverage This "workers' compensation insurance" covers medical expenses and pays a portion of wages lost while a worker recovers from a workplace injury
